COPTHORNE RECREATION GROUND

We have now completed the tender evaluation process for a civils package of work (which includes construction of the car park, paved areas, playground base, paths and hard landscaping) and the preferred supplier will be agreed by the Finance & General Purposes Committee at their meeting on 7th July. We are now in the process of writing a number of applications for S106 monies to help finalise funding arrangements. It is hoped that this can be completed in time for discussion at the next Full Council meeting on 21st July. Once the project budget and funding plans have been agreed by Council we will liaise with all of the contractors to agree dates that works can commence. SPEEDING WITHIN THE VILLAGE

The Copthorne Village Community Speedwatch are still in desperate need of volunteers and are appealing for more to come forward. Being a volunteer can involve as little as one hour every two or three weeks, although if you'd like to do more that would be welcomed. They now have 2,500 volunteers across Sussex, with 190 Parish Councils and 15 Wardens carrying out Community Speedwatch initiatives. They issue 5,000 letters per month to drivers for speeding; from this they only have a repeat offender rate of less than 5% out of the 60,000 or so letters sent over the year, which means drivers really do take notice.

Monday 3.30-5.30pm at The Haven Centre in Crawley Down

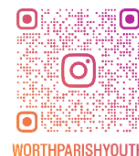
For Years 5 and up. They are completely FREE!
