We say goodbye to Chris Mayor and thank him for his past service. In Copthorne, all the sitting Councillors were re-elected. Councillor Tony Dorey was confirmed as Chair of the Council at the Annual Council Meeting. You will find a list and contact details for all our Councillors at the end of this newsletter.

Now your Parish Council is in full swing, we are continuing to progress many of our exciting projects for the villages of Copthorne and Crawley Down. These include fitting an electricity supply to both village greens to power the community events that happen on our land, CCTV for both villages, the Bowers Place parking solution for Crawley Down and our vision to renovate Copthorne Recreation Ground to name a few. This is all part of Our Vision to:

ensure a true "village feel" and that Crawley Down and Copthorne are safe, attractive and enjoyable places for our existing and future residents to live.

As we go to print, we have been informed of the collapse of Sussex Clubs for Young People (SCYP) who the Council had engaged to deliver youth club services. This is a major setback, but we have reacted quickly and are working hard behind the scenes to ensure our youth clubs can reopen. CRAWLEY DOWN WORKING PARTY

It's been a busy time for the Parish Council in Crawley Down, with many of our initiatives starting to come to fruition!

The Village Centre. This continues to be a priority. We welcome Duman, a new restaurant but were sad to see the closure of Velvety Ginger. We have been helping SUP Foods find a new spot for their mobile coffee shop so they can continue to offer a service with less pressure on parking. Our planters to cheer things up should arrive shortly. The introduction of CCTV, is now described as "imminent". This will augment the work of the PCSOs, who will continue their work in the village, and should help prevent antisocial behaviour. BT has mended the formerly defunct telephone box. We had hoped they would remove it so we could use its site for the upgrade of the noticeboards! Rest assured noticeboard improvements will come shortly!

Village Events. The Haven Centre Food Festival and Funfair on Coronation weekend was an outstanding success and crowds flocked to enjoy a wide variety of activities and foods both to buy and to eat from oysters to chocolate, speciality gin to cheese. The weather was good! and the younger children enjoyed the funfair rides and the children's games area. It culminated in a lively curry night with music. The event showcased The Haven Centre and its facilities. Our thanks to the organisers, a small group led by new Councillor, Thérèse Wilson.

Worth Parish Council is also supporting the CDRA who are running the Gig on the Green on 29 July and the Crawley Down Village Fayre on 9 September.

Youth Club. We are looking forward to the group being able to build on its successful launch at the start of the next school year. 16 youngsters had great fun at the most recent session. The club, aimed at 10-13 year olds, was always designed to operate during term time.

Bowers Place Parking. The scheme to improve parking in Bowers Place is ongoing; it is hoped to start construction work in early autumn. The Council will try to minimise disruption while it is carried out.

Litter Picking. Crawley Down's "wombles" continue to try to keep the village clean and tidy. Our session in March saw 8 volunteers collect 8 bags of litter. Our next session will be on Sunday 30th July. All volunteers needed and welcome!
