About Worth Parish Council

Within Worth Parish there are two villages – Copthorne and Crawley Down. Combined, we have a population of approximately 11,000 and are the largest parish in the Mid Sussex District.

This area is currently covered by three councils – West Sussex County Council, Mid Sussex District Council and Worth Parish Council.

Following the Local Government Review, Worth will no longer be served by West Sussex County Council and Mid Sussex District Council, but by one single Unitary Authority. Worth Parish Council will remain, although it may take on more assets and services currently offered by the other councils.

Mission Statement

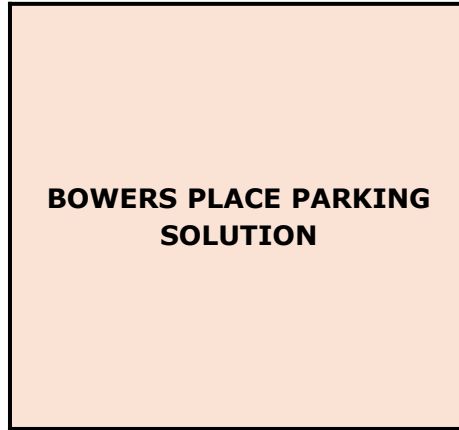
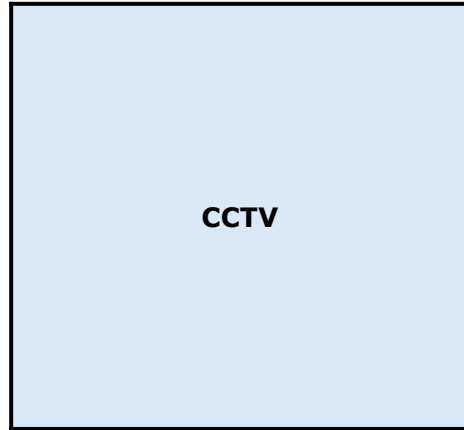
To identify, support and provide resources for initiatives that develop and maintain the delivery of efficient and cost-effective services and amenities for our community.

Action Plans

We're developing detailed timelines for projects in:

Copthorne – war memorial, improvements at Lashmere, opening up Copthorne Brook, improvements to footpaths and roads, additional sports facilities

Crawley Down – village centre upgrades, Worth Way pond improvements, Royal Oak solution, road improvements, comprehensive cycling routes

Council-wide – youth services, asset management, neighbourhood planning, street lighting, Local Government Reorganisation, civic pride & developing resources
