# WORTH PARISH COUNCIL UPDATE

#### **Copthorne Recreation Ground –**

We are looking to appoint a Project Manager to oversee all phases of the Copthorne Recreation Ground Project. This includes the building of the Multi-Use Games Area (MUGA), the installation of a new playground and a carpark (subject to planning permission).

Before work commences, we need to ensure we have detailed drainage strategies in place for the whole site. We also need to consider the location of CCTV at this location and the best time for it to be installed with all the groundwork required on this site.

Sadly, we were not successful in our application for the Community Ownership Fund to support the r**ejuvenation of the playground**. We are now discussing whether to submit a further application and will be liaising with Mid Sussex County Council about the possibility of further Section 106 monies being agreed to pay for the new playground.

We are currently liaising with our Preferred Supplier for **CCTV in Copthorne and Crawley Down** to resolve the connectivity and wayleaves issues (the agreement required between the landowners and those who will access the land to do the work to install, service, maintain, repair, and replace the CCTV equipment). We will provide a further update once these have been resolved and installation dates can be agreed.
