## CRAWLEY DOWN ENVIRONMENT GROUP

To guide the activities and investment by the Parish Council over the medium term (2 to 5 years), a Vision Document is being developed for the two Villages, Crawley Down and Copthorne, that comprise the Parish of Worth.

The Crawley Down Infrastructure and Environment Group, a Working Group of the Council has been setup to focus on the aspects of this Vision for Crawley Down.

The Group has initially identified the following important issues which it will be seeking to progress.

- Changes to the Village Centre to make the retail space more attractive, more accessible and with a more comprehensive range of commercial outlets
- Traffic and other environmental issues such as litter affecting the quality of life of those living in the Village

- The ongoing provision of essential education and health services so as to keep pace with the increasing and changing demands of residents
- Safe and improved facilities for our Young People
- Improving awareness of, and access to, the countryside and its wildlife both within and adjacent to the Village.

The Working Group includes Parish Councillors and representatives of Village organisations and would welcome additional members willing to get involved. A litter-picking initiative is planned for the Village, with equipment supplied, for late June/early July.
