The Crawley Down Environment & Infrastructure Working Party has been formed by Worth Parish Council to help it engage with other key stakeholders in the Village, such as the Residents Association, to create a Vision for the way that the Village could develop over the short and medium term to make it an even more desirable place to live and raise a family.

As an example, there is a small group who have organised litter picking; they can now borrow equipment from the Council for this and get more publicity for what they are doing. Indeed, there was a Litter Pick on July 10th when, in slightly inclement weather, a team of 10 met in the Car Park.
